

THE CHARITABLE TRUSTS ORDINANCE

THE NYABOR MUSLIM (CHARITABLE TRUST) ORDER, 1968

(Made under section 3)

In the matter of a Charitable Trust to be known as the Nyabor Muslim Charitable Trust.

WHEREAS there exists in Nyabor, Kalaka, a trust in the property which is held for the charitable purposes indicated in the Schedule:

AND WHEREAS it appears to the Governor in Council that such trust constitutes a charitable trust within the meaning of the Charitable Trusts Ordinance, and that it would be to the advantage of the said trust that it should be administered and managed by a Board appointed as provided in section 3 of the said Ordinance:

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor by section 3 of the Charitable Trusts Ordinance, the following Order has been made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the **Nyabor Muslim (Charitable Trust) Order, 1968.** Citation.

2. There shall be appointed a Board to be known as the Nyabor Muslim Charitable Trust Board consisting of eleven members to administer and manage the trust property for the purposes set forth in the Schedule. <sup>ment of Board.</sup>

3. The said Board shall, subject to the terms of any order which may be made by the High Court, administer and manage the property held by it in accordance with the provisions of the Charitable Trusts Ordinance. <sup>Duties of Board.</sup>

SCHEDULE

(Article 2)

TRUST PURPOSES

1. The advancement of the Muslim religion including the provision and maintenance of suitable places of worship, for the Muslim community in Nyabor.
2. The burial of the dead among such community.
3. Any other charitable purposes which will be for the benefit of the Muslim community in Nyabor.
